King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang Announcement of Direct Admission (Second Round) Bachelor of Engineering in Software Engineering, Academic Year 2012

The International College, King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang, would like to announce the direct admission (second round) by submission of academic records and interview for entry to the **Bachelor of Engineering in Software Engineering** program in academic year 2012. Application and selection criteria are as follows:

1. Applicant Qualifications

The applicant's qualifications are required to meet the requirements specified in section 1.1, 1.2, and 1.3 below. The applicant is advised to contact the International College if the applicant is not certain whether his/her qualifications are eligible.

1.1 General academic requirements

The applicant must satisfy one of the following requirements:

- Graduated or studying in Matthayom 6
- Graduated or studying in the final year of a 12-Year or 13-Year education in an international school in Thailand or in a high school/secondary school abroad
- Graduated or studying in the final year of a vocational program in a college (in Thailand or abroad) in which the main language of instruction is English and, when completed, obtained a qualification which is equivalent to Matthayom 6 or higher
- Obtained a qualification equivalent to Matthayom 6 as being approved by the Ministry of Education of Thailand.

1.2 Requirements on academic record

The applicant's academic record must satisfy one of the following requirements:

- The applicant's combined grade point average for all courses in mathematics and computing-related subjects (if any) as reported in the applicant's latest academic transcript is no less than 2.75 in 4.0 scale (or equivalent).
- The applicant has obtained <u>one of the following test scores</u> which meets the minimum requirement specified:

- SAT (Math section) or SAT Subject test (Math Level I or Math Level II)
 with a score of 600 or above
- GCE A-Level or GCE AS-Level with grade B or above in a subject in mathematics or computing
- O-Level or GCSE or IGCSE with grade B or above in a subject in mathematics or computing
- IB-Diploma with a score of at least 5 in a subject in mathematics or computing
- GED (Math test) with a score of 600 or above
- AP test with a score of 3 or above in a subject in mathematics or computing
- CU-AAT (Math section) with a score of 480 or above

Only a score report which is valid (i.e. not expired) on the date of the interview will be considered.

1.3 English-language requirements

The applicant must fulfill one of the following requirements on English language proficiency:

- The applicant's combined grade point average for all courses in English language study as reported in the applicant's latest academic transcript is not less than 2.75 in 4.0 scale (or equivalent).
- The applicant has been studying for one year or longer in an international school in Thailand or in a school or a college outside Thailand in which the main language of instruction is English.
- The applicant has obtained <u>one of the following test scores</u> which meets the minimum requirement specified :
 - IELTS score of at least 5.0 with no subtest score below 4.0
 - TOEFL score of least 173 on computer-based testing or 61 on Internetbased testing
 - CU-TEP score of at least 60
 - TU-GET score of at least 450
 - SAT (Verbal section or Critical reading section) score of at least 400

Only a score report which is valid (i.e. not expired) on the date of the interview will be considered.

2. Numbers of Acceptances

Total acceptances are 10 students. The International College may accept a lower number of students if there are insufficient qualified applicants.

3. Admission Procedure

1) Application filing period The applicant submits his/her application and supporting documents by postal mail (see below for detail).	13 March 2012 - 27 April 2012
2) Announcement of the interview shortlist The admission committee will select the applicants who are qualified for interview based on the applicants' academic records as specified by the applicants' applications and submitted documents. The list of qualified applicants for interview will be announced on www.reg.kmitl.ac.th and www.reg.kmitl.ac.th and www.ic.kmitl.ac.th /se.	4 May 2012
3) Interview The interview will be held at the International College.	11 May 2012
4) Announcement of the accepted applicants The list of successful applicants will be announced on www.reg.kmitl.ac.th and www.ic.kmitl.ac.th/se . The decision made by the admission committee is final.	15 May 2012
5) Enrollment and payment Admitted applicants are required to enroll as new students in the program and pay the tuition fee during the specified period. The detail of the enrollment process will be announced on www.reg.kmitl.ac.th and www.ic.kmitl.ac.th/se .	31 May 2012 (tentative)
6) Start of Semester 1/2012 Please note that the International College has shifted the start date of the new academic year to 6 August 2012.	6 August 2012 (tentative)

4. Submission of Application and Supporting Documents

4.1 Application and supporting documents

- a. A completed and signed application form

- b. A recent one-inch color photo of the applicant
- c. A photocopy of the applicant's national identification card or passport
- d. A photocopy of the applicant's name-change certificate (if any)
- e. A latest official academic transcript

If the applicant has already graduated, a final official transcript should be sent with the application. Otherwise, the applicant should send the latest official transcript available at the time the application is made, and if there is any subsequent update, the applicant is required to bring the most up-to-date official transcript on the day of the interview.

The applicant may send a photocopy of his/her academic transcript with the application instead of an original one, in which case the applicant is required to bring an original copy of the official transcript on the day of the interview.

f. Score reports for English language tests and/or mathematics tests (if applicable)

Photocopies of the score reports for the applicable English tests and/or mathematics tests should be sent with the application. However, in case a score report is not available at the time the application is made, the applicant must indicate in his/her application form which test the applicant is waiting for the result, and then send a copy of the score report to the International College once the test result becomes available. In any case, the applicant is required to bring the official score reports for the applicable English tests and/or mathematics tests on the day of the interview and present them to the examiners.

g. An academic portfolio (if any)

The applicant may send his/her academic portfolio and any additional supporting document with the application. Alternatively, the applicant can bring those documents on the day of the interview and present them to the examiners.

Please note that only the documents which are valid at the time the consideration is made will be considered.
