

Announcement of Quota Admission Bachelor of Engineering in Software Engineering, Academic Year 2013 International College, King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang

The International College, King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang, would like to announce the quota admission for students with excellent academic record for entry to the **Bachelor of Engineering in Software Engineering** program in Academic Year 2013. The admission criteria and the application process are as follows:

1. Applicant qualifications

The applicant is required to meet the requirements specified in section 1.1, 1.2, and 1.3 below. The applicant is advised to contact the International College if not certain whether his/her qualification is eligible.

1.1 Educational background

The applicant must satisfy one of the following requirements:

- a) Graduated or studying in Matthayom 6,
- b) Graduated or studying in the final year of a 12-Year or 13-Year education in an international school in Thailand or in a high school/secondary school abroad,
- c) Graduated or studying in the final year in a school which has a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on academic cooperation with KMITL,
- d) Graduated or studying in the final year of a vocational program in a college in Thailand or abroad in which the main language of instruction is English and, when completed, obtained a qualification which is equivalent to Matthayom 6 or higher,
- e) Obtained (or expect to obtain before the beginning of Academic Year 2013) a qualification equivalent to Matthayom 6 as being approved by the Ministry of Education of Thailand.

1.2 Academic records

The applicant should possess an excellent academic record. The applicant's overall grade point average (GPA) as reported in the applicant's latest academic transcript must be no less than 3.0 in the 4.0 scale, or equivalent.

1.3 English language requirements

The applicant must fulfill <u>one of the following requirements</u> on English language proficiency:

- a) The applicant's combined grade point average for all courses in English language study as reported in the applicant's latest academic transcript is not less than 3.0 in 4.0 scale, or equivalent.
- b) The applicant has been studying for one year or longer in an international school in Thailand or in a school or a college outside Thailand in which the main language of instruction is English.
- c) The applicant has obtained <u>one of the following test scores</u> and meets the minimum requirement specified:
 - IELTS score of at least 5.0 with no subtest score below 4.0
 - TOEFL score of at least 61 on Internet-based testing or 500 on paper-based testing
 - CU-TEP score of at least 60
 - TU-GET score of at least 450
 - SAT (Critical reading section) score of at least 400

Only a score report which is valid (i.e. not expired) on the date of the interview will be considered.

2. Number of acceptances

The International College expects to accept 20 students from this quota admission. The International College may accept a lower or greater number of students depending on the number of qualified applicants.

3. Admission schedule

2) Announcement of the interview shortlist The admission committee will select the applicants who are qualified for interview based on the applicants' academic records. The list of qualified applicants for interview will be announced on www.ic.kmitl.ac.th/se .	30 November 2012
3) Interview The interview will be held at the International College.	5 December 2012
4) Announcement of the accepted applicants The list of successful applicants will be announced on the website www.ic.kmitl.ac.th/se . The decision made by the admission committee is final.	7 December 2012
5) Start of Semester 1/2013 Semester 1 of Academic Year 2013 is expected to begin in early August 2013. Prior to the start of the semester, there will be a pre-sessional course and an orientation session in which all the new students should attend. The actual dates will be announced later on the International College website.	Early August 2013

4. Application submission

4.1 Application and supporting documents

- a) A completed and signed application form
 The application form can be downloaded from www.ic.kmitl.ac.th/se.
- b) A recent one-inch color photo of the applicant
- c) A photocopy of the applicant's national identification card or passport
- d) A photocopy of the applicant's name-change certificate (if any)
- e) A latest official academic transcript

If the applicant has already graduated, a final official transcript should be sent with the application. Otherwise, the applicant should send the latest official transcript available at the time the application is made, and if there is any subsequent update, the applicant is required to bring the most up-to-date official transcript on the day of the interview.

The applicant may send a photocopy of his/her academic transcript with the application instead of an original one, in which case the applicant is required to bring an original copy of his/her academic transcript on the day of the interview.

f) Score report for an applicable English language test (if required)

A photocopy of the score report for an applicable English language test should be sent with the application. However, in case a score report is not available at the time the application is made, the applicant must indicate in his/her application form which test the applicant is waiting for the result, and then send a photocopy of the score report to the International College once the test result becomes available. In any case, the applicant is required to bring his/her official score report for an applicable English language test on the day of the interview and present it to the examiners.

g) An academic portfolio (if any)

The applicant may send his/her academic portfolio and any additional supporting document with the application. Alternatively, the applicant can bring those documents on the day of the interview and present them to the examiners.

Please note that only the documents which are valid at the time the consideration is made will be considered.

The tuition fee is 67,000 THB per semester. This fee does <u>not</u> cover optional extra overseas training.
